MINUTE OF ORDER

UPON hearing the Claimant in person and Counsel for the Defendants

AND UPON the trial of the issue as to whether the Claimant and the Defendants entered into a concluded and legally binding agreement to settle by way of compromise the Action 1998 T 720, as ordered by the Honourable Mr Justice MacKay on 11th May 2001

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Claimant and the Defendants entered into a concluded and legally binding agreement on 10 March 2001 to settle by way of compromise the Action 1998 T 720 on the terms set out in the schedule annexed hereto.
2. The Claimant's claims shall be dismissed forthwith.
3. The Claimant shall pay to the Defendants the sum of £9,500 towards the Defendants' costs within 7 days of the date of this Order, the Defendants

hereby relinquishing their claim to payment of any further costs in this Claim, save for those set out at paragraph 4.

4. In addition to the costs at paragraph 3, the Claimant shall pay the Defendants' costs in respect of the trial of this issue, such costs to be subject to detailed assessment if not agreed.
